## Townhome steals the show for newlywed actors

Actors David and Michelle (Weissgerber) Tibble, who were married in January 2013, casually began their search for a new home by driving north on Northwest Highway from Chicago. Along the way, they spotted a billboard for Lexington Park, a community of 149 townhomes in northwest-suburban Des Plaines built by Chicago-based Lexington Homes.

"We met in Arlington Heights when we were acting in a play together, so we were familiar with the Northwest suburbs," David says. "We just drove along the Metra train line and started looking at places. Our first stop was Lexington Park. We saw one or two other townhomes after that, but Lexington set the bar pretty high. We searched online, too, and didn't see any other homes comparable to what Lexington offered."

Lexington Park is located at 1238 Harding Ave., within walking distance of downtown Des Plaines and the Metra. The community offers three floor plans ranging from 1,605 to 1,913 square feet. Base-priced from the low \$240,000s, the three-story homes have two to three bedrooms, two and a half baths and attached two-car garages. The community is 90 percent sold.
