Located at Kirchoff and Library roads, Lexington Crossing offers townhomes ranging from 1,603 to 1,913 square feet. Homes are base-priced from \$299,990, and buyers can choose from three floor plans that offer two to three bedrooms, two-and-a-half baths and attached two-car garages. Plans are flexible and offer multiple options.
